Introducing the PH48 Pipe Handler

Utility contractors will want to know that there's another way to handle pipe.

Twenty-foot pipe sections are a wide load to carry on forks. So when space is limited get the job done with the IMx PH48 Pipe Handler. All you need is an area wide enough for a skidsteer.

Many jobs are too tight to be giving up 20-ft. corridors to moving pipe. For instance, an urban sewer or water line rehabilitation. Narrow streets make it tough on a contractor, but just transporting pipe up and down the street could require the closing of even more lanes of traffic. Or for that matter, just installing lines in any developed area can be a problem.

Eliminate those problems with the IMx PH48. Grapple all sorts of pipes with the 48" opening and carry them in line with the skidsteer. Thread pipes like PVC, Ductile Iron, Galvanized, Concrete Drainage Tiles, and more through narrow openings and in tight spaces like alongside buildings. Release loads precisely. Place the far tip where you want it, turn your skidsteer and the grapple rotates to let you put the pipe at the exact angle you need it.

Working in a tight space isn't the only advantage. Using a small skidsteer to handle pipe means larger loaders on the job are available for the big tasks they were meant to do like handling aggregate, backfilling, grading and more. No more switching buckets and forks in order to keep up with needs of the pipe fitters in the trench. And the grapple can pickup a wide variety of other common items like valves, risers, and more without the operator leaving the seat.
